Dear Fifth Grader,

We hope you will have a fabulous summer!

Even though summer has just started, we wanted you to have enough time to take advantage of all the early school supply specials. Fifth grade will be the best! It is a year packed with learning, activities, and fun!

As you know, next year you will have three teachers. Your teachers will be Mrs. Lafata, Ms. Amadon, and Ms. Wentzell. It doesn't matter who you have as your homeroom teacher because you will be spending one third of the day in each of the three rooms. Ms. Amadon will be teaching fiction reading, writing and social studies. Ms. Wentzell will be teaching nonfiction reading, writing, and science. Mrs. Lafata will be teaching math.

We have most of the supplies you will need. However, there are a few things that would be helpful for you to bring in:

- Ticonderoga number 2 pencils – We know they are a little more expensive, but they last MUCH longer.
- ear buds for computers (any will do, but Dollar Tree Store has them in stock)
- a small, hand-held pencil sharpener
- several rectangle erasers
- 12 count box colored pencils
- a glue stick
- small scissors
- a black sharpie
- a zippered, flat pencil pouch – small enough to carry between classes – NO boxes, binders, or 'trapper keepers'
- 2 marbled composition notebooks (You may want to buy extra while on sale. We will most likely need more throughout the school year).
- a 4-pack of expo dry erase markers
- a small, new, white sock to use as an expo eraser
- 1 package lined wide ruled 3 hole filler paper

At this time, **no** other school supplies are needed.

Not necessary, but always helpful:

- Clorox wipes, tissues, paper towels
