Dear Future Fourth Grader,

We hope you have a wonderful summer. On this Move-Up Day you may not be thinking about what you need for 4th grade, but your parents may want to take advantage of some early sales for your supplies.

Our classrooms do have most of the supplies you will need; however, there are a few things that would be helpful for you to bring in:

- A zippered, flat pouch – small enough to carry – **NO** boxes, binders, or trapper keepers
- Boxes of Ticonderoga number 2 pencils – they last much longer than the other brands
- Earbuds for computers (any will do, the Dollar Store has them in stock)
- Small, hand-held pencil sharpener
- Several rectangle erasers, **NO PENCIL TOP ERASERS**
- 24-pack crayons
- Highlighter
- Colored pen
- Two sturdy 2-pocket folders
- Glue sticks
- Small scissors
- Black sharpie
- Three 4-packs fine-tip Expo dry erase markers
- Pair of new, small white socks to use as an Expo eraser
- 3 Marble Composition notebooks (100 pages) **PLEASE NO SPIRAL BOUND NOTEBOOKS**
- **HELPFUL SUPPLIES:** Clorox wipes, tissues, paper towels, hand soap

Students will NOT have desks, so it is important that they do not bring more than they need to school. There will be no place to store supplies, so please keep extras at home. All supplies MUST fit into the small pouches (not hard pencil boxes!).
