HOW does it work? Honoring a teacher is easy! There are two ways to honor a teacher and make a donation:

- **Online** - Log onto www.thinkthebest.org and click on the “Honor a Teacher” button on the right-hand side of the home page. Follow the prompts to complete the donor form and process a secure debit/credit card payment or donation via PayPal.
- **Mail** – Simply use the form with this letter or download a form from www.thinkthebest.org (or pick up a form from your child’s school) and then place the completed form along with your donation, payable to “**GEF**”, in the mail.
